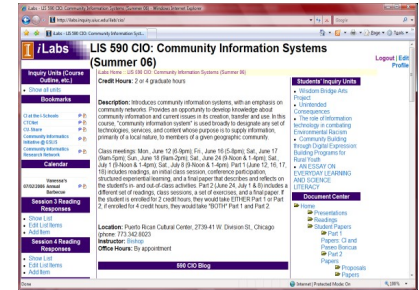
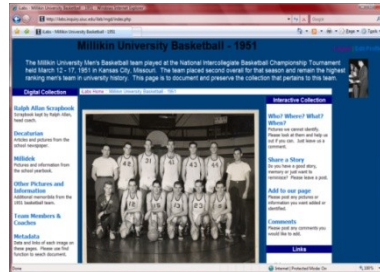
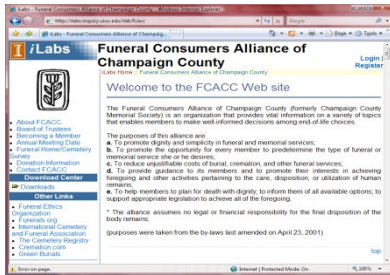


Community Inquiry Labs (iLabs)
